

1 (c) The City Manager is authorized to recommend up to two (2) additional three (3)-year
2 extensions of this agreement, as necessary, if deemed to be in the best interests of the City.

3 **Section 2.** Funds for the services provided in these agreements are available in the Little Rock
4 Information Technology Department's Annual Operating Budget.

5 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any portion of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid
6 or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this
7 ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or
8 unconstitutional were not originally a part of this ordinance.

9 **Section 4. Repealer.** All ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, which are in conflict with any
10 provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

11 **Section 5. Emergency Clause.** *As has been demonstrated in the annual City financial audit, the need*
12 *for certain security training is mandated for a municipality that participates in certain programs and*
13 *accepts certain funds, and that such training is critical to the public health, safety, and welfare; an*
14 *emergency is, therefore, declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after*
15 *the date of its passage.*
