A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH DELL INCORPORATED, FOR THE PURCHASE OF THIRTY-TWO (32) LAPTOP COMPUTERS FOR THE NEWLY-PURCHASED PATROL VEHICLES FOR THE LITTLE ROCK POLICE DEPARTMENT, IN THE TOTAL PURCHASE PRICE OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED NINE AND 55/100 DOLLARS (\$115,409.55), UTILIZING THE ARKANSAS STATE CONTRACT PURCHASING AGREEMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Little Rock Police Department is in need of thirty-two (32) Laptop Computers for service in newly-purchased Patrol Vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, by utilizing the Arkansas State Contract, the Little Rock Police Department can purchase thirty-two (32) Laptop Computers from Dell Incorporated to equip for service the newly-purchased Patrol Vehicles, for the total cost of One Hundred Fifteen Thousand, Four Hundred Nine and 55/100 Dollars (\$115,409.55).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to utilize the Arkansas State Contract to enter into a contract with Dell Incorporated for the purchase of thirty-two (32) Laptop Computers to equip for service of the newly-purchased Patrol Vehicles at a total cost of One Hundred Fifteen Thousand, Four Hundred Nine and 55/100 Dollars (\$115,409.55).

Section 2. Funds for this purchase are allocated in the 2015 Short Term Finance Account.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution.

Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
