

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ALL SERVICE ELECTRIC, INC., IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY-ONE AND 20/100 DOLLARS (\$113,881.20), FOR THE STAGECOACH ROAD EMERGENCY USE TRAFFIC SIGNAL; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Bids were solicited to install an Emergency Use Traffic Signal at the new Fire Station 24, Bid #742, and,

WHEREAS, All Service Electric, Inc., was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with All Service Electric, Inc., for the Stagecoach Road Emergency Traffic Signal, in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thirteen Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty-One and 20/100 Dollars (\$113,881.20), which is the base bid amount of Ninety-Four Thousand, Nine Hundred One Dollars (\$94,901.00), plus 20% contingencies.

Section 2. Funding for this project is from a Street Fund Special Project Account.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the resolution.

Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
