SYNOPSIS	<p>A resolution to renew the Interlocal Agreement with Pulaski County for MEMS to have the exclusive jurisdiction for Ambulance Services within the County.</p>

BACKGROUND	<p>MEMS, through the Little Rock Ambulance Authority, has entered into Interlocal Agreements with various local governments since 1986. In 1987, they entered into an Agreement with Pulaski County to have the exclusive right to provide Ambulance Services within the County. These Interlocal Agreements do not increase ambulance rates for Little Rock citizens, as everyone pays the same rates. The Pulaski County Quorum Court approved this Interlocal Agreement at its meeting on September 22, 2020, and this resolution authorizes the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.</p>
