

1 **Section 1.** The Mayor and Members of the Board of Directors ask the Arkansas Congressional
2 delegation, either individual or as a group, to publicly meet with the Board of Directors of the City of Little
3 Rock, Arkansas, and any other Pulaski County governing body that wishes to attend, so the true impact of
4 lost revenues from Internet sales can be demonstrated, particularly when Sales and Compensating Use
5 Taxes are one of the few means that Arkansas municipalities have to raise funds for public services.

6 **Section 2.** The Mayor is directed to send an executed copy of this resolution to each member of the
7 Arkansas Congressional Delegation, and to work with City Staff to coordinate a public meeting in an
8 appropriate location for a detailed discussion of this issue, preferably during one of the Congressional
9 recesses before the end of 2017.

10 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
11 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
12 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
13 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
14 resolution.

15 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
16 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
