<p>SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to modify the contract with Tetra Tech, Inc., for Monitoring Services of debris collection related to disaster recovery from the March 31, 2023, EF-3 Tornado.</p>	
<p>FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>The amount of this project is \$200,000.00, for a total revised contract amount of \$969,677.00, and extend the contract timeframe to June 1, 2024. Funding for this project is from the FEMA Account No. 270409DF231-63390, as authorized by Resolution No. 15,957.</p>
