

1 adopted by reference. There is hereby adopted by reference a "Flood Damage Prevention
2 Code for the City of Little Rock, Arkansas," dated February 26, 2021. The Code shall
3 include:

4 Article 1 Definitions;

5 Article 2 Administration;

6 Article 3 Provisions for Flood Hazard Reduction.

7 A copy of the referenced Code shall be filed in the Office of the Pulaski County Circuit
8 Clerk and shall be available for inspection and copying during normal business hours.

9 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
10 word of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
11 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance which shall remain in full force and
12 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
13 ordinance.

14 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with
15 the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

16 **Section 5. Emergency Clause.** *The ability to maintain a consistent Property Maintenance Code*
17 *applicable to readily identifiable properties is essential to the public health, safety and welfare; an*
18 *emergency is, therefore, declared to exist so this ordinance can take effect, and be in full force and effect,*
19 *from and after February 26, 2021.*
