2 **Section 2.** Funds for these programs are from the 2019 PIT Allocation, Account No. 108159-
3 S15A923.

4 **Section 3.** The term for each contract listed in Section 1 of this resolution shall be for a period of six
5 (6) months with a start date of January 1, 2019, and an understanding that the City ratifies, accepts, and
6 will compensate any work done between January 1, 2019, and the effective date of the approved contract.
7 The City, in its sole discretion and upon mutual agreement of the parties, may extend a contract for a one
8 (1), six (6)-month period to begin July 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019.

9 **Section 4.** All payments are conditioned upon entry into contracts for services that are in a form
10 acceptable to the City Attorney; further, nothing in this resolution prevents the City from being able to
11 offer similar services to any vendor during 2019 if, in its sole discretion, it decides to do so.

12 **Section 5. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
13 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
14 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and
15 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the
16 resolution.

17 **Section 6. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent
18 with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
