<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Redstone Construction Group, Inc., for the Fourche Dam Pike Widening, near Interstate 440 to south of Sloane Drive and Frazier Pike, Economic Development Administration Project, 08-79-0377, Bid No. 1080.</p> <p>The amount for Construction Services is not to exceed \$3,058,639.64, which is the base bid amount of \$2,548,866.37, plus 20% contingencies. Funding for this project is a grant from the Economic Development Administration with local match funds from the Job Recruitment/Economic Development set-aside in the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax in a partnership with Pulaski County.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>This project provides street widening and storm sewers extensions Fourche Dam Pike from south of Interstate 440 to south of Sloane at Frazier Pike. The project also includes signal installation at Lindsey Road and Frasier Pike, as well as railroad crossing improvements. Redstone Construction Group, Inc., was the lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of two (2) bids received for the project.</p>
