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| SYNOPSIS | A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Presidio Networked Solutions for the purchase of Video Conference Equipment for the Little Rock Police Department Headquarters. |
| FISCAL IMPACT | The amount of this project is \$174,875.26, plus applicable taxes and fees, and funds are available from Federal American Rescue Funds Account No. 271529-G0601AR52A. |
| RECOMMENDATION | Approval of the ordinance |
| BACGROUND | <p>The new Little Rock Police Headquarters building located at 615 West Markham Street has been completed and occupied. While the building has been suitable for occupation, there are projects that still need to be completed within the facility. One of the significant remaining projects is to equip the Assistant Chief Clarence Hunter Conference Room with audio/visual equipment that will enable the Conference Room to function as a command post and support video/audio conferencing.</p> <p>In addition, the facility designed to include a large conference room capable of hosting a variety of meetings, classes, etc., and the unique location of the building makes it an ideal location for hosting these types of events.</p> |

**BACKGROUND
CONTINUED**

While the building has been completed, the IT related support equipment needed to provide connectivity to the conference room has not been purchased and installed. The current plan includes the installation of a total of eight (8) large screen monitors, three (3) voice tracking cameras, ceiling mounted speakers and microphones, and two (2) control boxes in a two (2)-phased project. The equipment will be purchased utilizing the State Contract SP-20-0051 Outline Agreement No. 4600048977.
