<p>SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into contracts with five (5) organizations to provide After-School/Out-of-School Time Positive Prevention Programs for 2024, as endorsed by the Commission on Children, Youth and Families.</p>	
<p>FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>The amount is not to exceed \$82,500.00 per program (six (6) programs), in the total amount of \$495,500.00, and funds for these programs are available from the 2024 PIT Allocation, Account No. 108159-S15C.</p>	
<p>RECOMMENDATION</p>	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
<p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>Bid No. 2326 was issued for After-School/Out-of-School Time Positive Prevention Programs for Little Rock youth ages six (6) – twelve (12), and four (4) organizations met the minimum score for funding. Bid No. 2334 was issued for After-School/Out-of-School Time Positive Prevention Programs for Little Rock youth ages thirteen (13) – eighteen (18), and two (2) organizations met the minimum score for funding.</p>	

**BACKGROUND
CONTINUED**

The term of the contracts shall be eleven (11) months from February 1, 2024, to December 31, 2024, with the option of extending the original contract up to two (2) additional one (1)-year terms of a calendar year (January 1st - December 31st), or a portion thereof, based on satisfactory performance and availability of funds for an amount not to exceed \$90,000.00 per contract per calendar year.

On January 3, 2024, the Commission on Children, Youth and Families met and voted to endorse these recommendations for contracts after successful negotiation.
