<p><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p>	<p>To authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Redstone Construction Group, Inc., for the 6<sup>th</sup> Street Drainage Improvements, Project No. 01-16-DR-10, Bid No. 794.</p>	
<p><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p>	<p>Amount for Construction Services is not to exceed \$236,969.10, which is the base bid amount of \$197,474.25, plus 20% contingencies. Funding for this project is from the 3/8-Cent Capital Improvement Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds and the 2018 Capital Improvement Bonds as authorized by Resolution No. 14,803.</p>

<p><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>This project provides storm sewer improvements for 6<sup>th</sup> Street in the area of Byrd, Collins and McLean Streets where older drainage systems are in need of rehabilitation and improvement. Redstone Construction Group, Inc., was the lowest, responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications of five (5) bids received for the project.</p>
