This Commission will help preserve the historical, cultural and aesthetic aspects of this area. For this reason, pursuant to A.C.A. § 14-172-207, with recommendations of approval from the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program, an agency of the Department of Parks Heritage and Tourism, the Little Rock Planning Commission, and the Little Rock Historic District Commission, the City of Little Rock Planning and Development Department, is proposing the creation of a Local Ordinance District to protect the historical assets and resources of the Central High School Neighborhood Historic District.
