

1 **Section 4. Emergency Clause.** *Since a comprehensive Third-Party Inspection and Reporting System*
2 *will greatly assist the City to track Fire Protection Systems, increase required inspections and*
3 *maintenance of all Fire Protection Equipment, reduce false alarms and ensure a safer community, this*
4 *system is essential to protect the public health, safety and welfare, therefore an emergency is declared to*
5 *exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of this adoption.*
