SYNOPSIS	<p>A resolution to renew the agreement with the City of Sherwood, Arkansas, for MEMS to have the exclusive jurisdiction for Ambulance Services within the City of Sherwood.</p>	
FISCAL IMPACT	<p>None. The Little Rock Ambulance Authority d/b/a MEMS is self-sufficient.</p>	
RECOMMENDATION	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
BACKGROUND	<p>MEMS, through the Little Rock Ambulance Authority, has entered into Interlocal Agreements with various local governments since 1986. In 1987, MEMS entered into an Agreement with the City of Sherwood, Arkansas, to have the exclusive right to provide Ambulance Services within the City of Sherwood. These Interlocal Agreements do not increase ambulance rates for Little Rock citizens - everyone pays the same rates. It is anticipated that the Sherwood City Council will approve the extension of this Interlocal Agreement. This resolution authorizes the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.</p>
