



1       **Section 2.** The City Manager is authorized to enter into contracts with the above-listed organizations  
2 providing Summer Recreation Programs and services, upon approval of the form of the contract by the  
3 City Attorney.

4       **Section 3.** Funds for these programs are drawn from the 2015 PIT Allocation, account number  
5 S15A490.

6       **Section 4.** The term of the contracts shall be June 16, 2015, to July 31, 2015.

7       **Section 5. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or  
8 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or  
9 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this resolution, which shall remain in full force and  
10 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the  
11 resolution.

12       **Section 6. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent  
13 with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
