

1 (e) Downtown Master Plan & Capital Needs: Estimated at One Million, Five Hundred
2 Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00).

3 (f) Real Time Crime Information Center: Estimated at One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00).

4 (g) Total: Twelve million, Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$12,350,000.00).

5 **Section 4. *Compliance with the American Rescue Plan Act.*** The City will ensure compliance with
6 prevailing Federal Law, regulations, and guidance, at the time the funds are committed to expenditures.

7 **Section 5.** Nothing in this resolution shall be construed as constituting an employment contract or as
8 altering, modifying or affecting the “at-will” employment relationship between the City and any relevant
9 City employee.

10 **Section 6. *Severability.*** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
11 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
12 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
13 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
14 resolution.

15 **Section 7. *Repealer.*** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with
16 the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
