<p>SYNOPSIS</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with Lonestar Tactical Buildings for the purchase of a Burn Building for the Little Rock Fire Department.</p>	
<p>FISCAL IMPACT</p>	<p>The amount is not to exceed \$632,432.51, plus applicable taxes and fees, and funding is allocated with American Rescue Plan Act Funds, Account No. 271519-G0601AR51C.</p>

<p>BACKGROUND</p>	<p>Little Rock, Ark., Resolution No. 15,783 (August 6, 2022) stated the intent to spend American Rescue Plan Act Funds on Fire Facility Improvements.</p> <p>The Burn Building will be used for Fire Incident Tactical Operation Training for recruits and in-service training. The building will replace the previous structure that was deemed unsafe.</p> <p>The City issued Bid No. 2456 and Lonestar Tactical Buildings was the only qualified bid received.</p>
