<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	<p>This resolution authorizes the City to enter into another three (3)-year extension of the Interlocal Agreement between MEMS and the City of Cabot, Arkansas.</p>	
<b>FISCAL IMPACT</b>	<p>The revenues from advanced life support and basic life support ambulance runs in the City of Cabot helps MEMS maintain operating revenue needed to meet its obligations.</p>	
<b>RECOMMENDATION</b>	<p>Approval of the resolution.</p>	
<b>BACKGROUND</b>	<p>MEMS, while created by and based within the City of Little Rock, has statutory authority to operate in other jurisdictions through Interlocal Agreements. The City and MEMS have had an exclusive franchise arrangement for such services since 2005. The last extension was executed in 2014; therefore, it is time to adopt a resolution to authorize another three (3)-year extension.</p>
