



1       **Section 2. Severability.** In the event any title, subtitle, section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph,  
2 subparagraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or work of this ordinance is declared or adjudged to be invalid  
3 or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the ordinance  
4 which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or  
5 unconstitutional was not originally a part of this ordinance.

6       **Section 3. Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same that are inconsistent with the  
7 provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency including, but not  
8 limited to, Little Rock, Ark., Ordinance No. 21,251 (June 7, 2016) codified as LRC § 5-58 (c) (1988).

9       **Section 5. Emergency Clause.** *The ability to efficiently and effectively provide emergency medical*  
10 *health services to all citizens is essential to the public health, safety, and welfare, and the ability to meet*  
11 *the actual needs of every patient with the appropriate level of care, while still maintaining some control*  
12 *over costs and resources, makes it possible to maintain such an important public service; this ordinance*  
13 *permits the Little Rock Ambulance Authority to permit some modification of the current tiers of service for*  
14 *care if such modification is appropriate and approved by the Arkansas Department of Health, and the*  
15 *Arkansas Emergency Physicians Foundation; an emergency, therefore, is declared to exist and this*  
16 *ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.*
