A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC., IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF EIGHTY-THREE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED NINETY-SIX AND 85/100 DOLLARS (\$83,296.85), PLUS APPLICABLE TAXES AND FEES, FOR THE PURCHASE OF PORTABLE AND MOBILE RADIO SYSTEMS FOR THE LITTLE ROCK FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Little Rock Fire Department is in need of Portable Radios and Mobile Radios for the Little Rock Fire Department Response Vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, by utilizing the Arkansas State Contract No. SP-16-0128, the Little Rock Fire Department can purchase ten (10) Portable Radios and five (5) Mobile Radios amount is not to exceed Eighty-Three Thousand, Two Hundred Ninety-Six and 85/100 Dollars (\$83,296.85), plus applicable taxes and fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The Board of Directors hereby authorizes the City Manager to utilize the Arkansas State Contract to enter into a contract with Motorola Solutions, Inc., for the purchase of ten (10) Portable Radios and five (5) Mobile Radios for the Little Rock Fire Department response vehicles at a total cost of Eighty-Three Thousand, Two Hundred Ninety-Six and 85/100 Dollars (\$83,296.85), plus applicable taxes and fees.

Section 2. Funds for this purchase are through Act 833, Account No. 210519-S00B250.

Section 3. Severability. In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not originally a part of the resolution.

Section 4. Repealer. All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
