<p><b>SYNOPSIS</b></p> <p><b>FISCAL IMPACT</b></p> <p><b>RECOMMENDATION</b></p> <p><b>BACKGROUND</b></p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the Manager to enter into a contract with Crafton Tull &amp; Associates, Inc., for Professional Engineering Consultant Services for the Rose Creek Trail Improvement Project.</p> <p>The agreement is not to exceed \$80,670.00, and funding for the project is from 3/8-Cent Sales and Compensating Use Tax Funds, Account No. TS40C32.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>The proposed Rose Creek Trail has been identified in the City of Little Rock Master Bike Plan as an important off-street bikeway route connecting the Arkansas River Trail to Rose Creek Park and the Capital View Neighborhood and has support of the community and affected private property owners. The proposed trail will be an extension of a trailhead connection to be constructed by the Arkansas Department of Transportation as part of the Federal-Aid Gill Street Project. The proposed contract provides for design plans and right-of-way documentation to prepare for future grant opportunities. Detailed plans and specifications prepared by a qualified Engineering Firm are required for the project.</p>
