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3 **A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER**
4 **INTO A CONTRACT WITH JAMES A. ROGERS EXCAVATING, INC., IN**
5 **AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-ONE**
6 **THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED FIVE AND 85/100 DOLLARS,**
7 **(\$121,305.85), FOR BENTLEY COURT PAVEMENT RECONSTRUCTION;**
8 **AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**
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10 **WHEREAS**, Bids were solicited for improvements for Bentley Court Pavement Reconstruction, Bid
11 No. 586; and,

12 **WHEREAS**, James A. Rogers Excavating, Inc., was the lowest responsive, responsible bid meeting
13 specifications.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY**
15 **OF LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS:**

16 **Section 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with James A. Rogers
17 Excavating, Inc., for Bentley Court Pavement Reconstruction in an amount not to exceed One Hundred
18 Twenty-One Thousand, Three Hundred Five and 85/100 Dollars, (\$121,305.85), which is the base bid
19 amount of One Hundred One Thousand, Eighty-Eight Dollars (\$101,088.00), plus 20% contingencies.

20 **Section 2.** Funding for this project is from proceeds from the ½-Cent State-Wide Sales Tax Turnback
21 Funds as a Street Fund Special Project.

22 **Section 3. Severability.** In the event any title, section, paragraph, item, sentence, clause, phrase, or
23 word of this resolution is declared or adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such declaration or
24 adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of the resolution which shall remain in full force and
25 effect as if the portion so declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional was not originally a part of the
26 resolution.

27 **Section 4. Repealer.** All laws, ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with
28 the provisions of this resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
