<p style="text-align: center;">SYNOPSIS</p> <p style="text-align: center;">FISCAL IMPACT</p> <p style="text-align: center;">RECOMMENDATION</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BACKGROUND</p>	<p>A resolution to authorize the City Manager or Mayor to execute agreements and accept the transfer of the Cumberland Street right-of-way from the Arkansas Department of Transportation.</p> <p>The City will be accepting maintenance responsibility for two (2) blocks of Cumberland Street, from President Clinton Avenue to 3rd Street.</p> <p>Approval of the resolution.</p> <p>This resolution authorizes the City Manager or Mayor to execute agreements and accept the transfer of the Cumberland Street right-of-way from the Arkansas Department of Transportation. The transfer will allow the City to widen sidewalks and make pedestrian enhancements to this portion of the downtown River Market area, from President Clinton Avenue south to 3rd Street. This will provide additional pedestrian-friendly connection from Clinton Avenue to the new park area created with the elimination of Interstate 30 ramps and to the businesses and homes in the 3rd Street area.</p>
